The Technical Controller is Brian Cook with BCPS as Supervisor. For each Grand Prix, a webpage will be provided in advance for solvers, where you will be presented with the appropriate schedule, supporting announcements and the choice of Category and Notation. Registration is optional but preferred (if only to identify a name rather than your eMail address for the Results and Final Report). Points are awarded according to WCSC guidelines. Results and Final Reports will be published as quickly as possible in the usual way; and also by eMail to all entrants.

For each GP, BOOM points will be awarded to the top 10 solvers as follows:

2. You should be able to participate on any PC, laptop, tablet or smart-phone with internet connection.
3. If the start time for any event or round is inconvenient then clickable buttons on the Tourney page will enable you to self-schedule to suit your circumstances.
4. You are trusted absolutely to observe established tournament conditions and to participate in a spirit of friendly rivalry. There are no prizes, grading or norm allocations.
5. When both physical and online events occur on the same day with the same problems then BOOM points are awarded according to a consolidated results table. The self-scheduling option will not be available on the day of the physical event, but will be thereafter.
