The tournament will be organized according to WCSC rules (6 rounds, 18 problems) in two groups A (open for everybody) and B (open only for solvers below rating 2000).

The level of the problems in group B will be similar to Category 2 of ISC competition. It will be calculated to the rating (if there are enough participants with the rating)

Rankings and titles of the players will be based on WFCC's official rating list.

junior (up to 23) - for participants of group A

women - for participants of group B

junior (up to 15) - for participants of group B

Financial rewards in group A

1st place - 500 PLN 2nd place - 300 PLN 3rd place - 150 PLN

The best player with a rating up to 2200 - 100 PLN

Financial rewards in group B

1st place - 150 PLN 2nd place - 100 PLN 3rd place - 50 PLN
